

Setting up your Droid Smart Phone to work with NEMR email.

NEMR does not allow relay of mail.

Incoming mail server settings

username = your nemr user name here

password = your nemr password here

POP3 server = mail.nemr.net

port = 110

Security type = none

Outgoing mail server settings

You will have to use gmail for this.


Sending Email using Gmail Outgoing Mail Server Settings (SMTP Settings)

- For the outgoing mail server information enter **smtp.gmail.com**
- Check (green) both **Use secure connection** and **Verify Certificate**
 - **Port 465.**
 - The username (Example: xxx)
 - Enter the Gmail account password.

To make the reply address looks like it is coming from your nemr email address.

Go to a computer and login to your gmail account ([click here](#))

Once logged in go to the upper right hand corner of the gmail account and click on mail settings.

Then click on Accounts and Import

In the Send mail as: click on Add another address you own

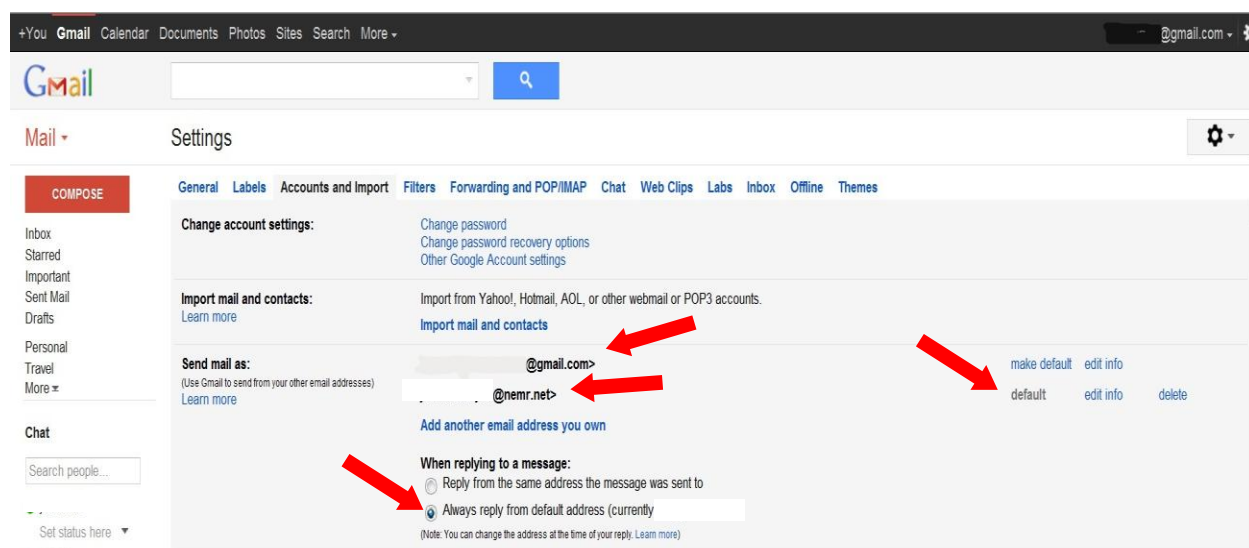
You will put your name and nemr email address in this location.

Once you have verified the email account you should go back to gmail.com and find 2 email addresses in the send mail as:



1 will be xxxxx@gmail.com and the other will be xxxx@nemr.net

Make sure you make the nemr.net account the default send mail account.

Put a dot in the - Always reply from default address (currently your email address here@nemr.net)
